It is the process of removing cotton seeds from cotton fibre by combing them.	It is the process of soaking the tied bundles of jute stalks in water for few days so that they rot and fibers are separated from them.

Yarn is a strand made by twisting fibres together.	Fabric is made by weaving or knitting the yarns.

Fibre	Fabric
These are twisted together to make yarns.	Yarns are weaved or knitted to make fabrics.
