## Reproduction in Plants

- Q1. Explain reproduction through spore formation in fungus.
- Ans. Fungi on a bread piece grow from spores which are present in the air.

  When spores are released they keep floating in the air. As they are very light they can cover long distances. Spores are asexual reproductive bodies. Each spore is covered by a hard protective coat to withstand unfavourable conditions such as high temperature and low humidity. So they can survive for a long time. Under favourable conditions, a spore germinates and develops into a new individual.
