Features of commercial farming

- ii. Most of the work is done by machines.
- iii. Commercial farming includes commercial grain farming, mixed farming and plantation agriculture.
- Q3. Name the fibre crops and the climatic conditions required for their growth.
- Ans. Jute and cotton are fibre crops. Climatic conditions required for their growth are:
 - <u>Cotton</u> Cotton requires high temperature, light rainfall, two hundred and ten frost-free days and bright sunshine for its growth. It grows best on black and alluvial soils.
 - <u>Jute</u> It grows well on alluvial soil and requires high temperature, heavy rainfall and humid climate.
