## Human Resources

- Ans. When people are attracted to an area it becomes densely populated.

  Factors that influence this include favourable climate; good supplies of natural resources and fertile land.
- Q2. What is meant by population composition?
- Ans. Population composition refers to the structure of the population.

The composition of population helps us to know how many are males or females, which age group they belong to, how educated they are and what type of occupations they are employed in, what their income levels and health conditions are.

- Q3. Why did world population rise from 1800 onwards?
- Ans. In 1820, the world's population reached one billion. A hundred and fifty years later, in the early 1970s, the world's population reached 3 billion. This is often called population explosion. In 1999, less than 30 years later, the population doubled to 6 billion. The main reason for this growth was that with better food supplies and medicine, deaths were reducing, while the number of births still remained fairly high.
