## Conservation of Plants and Animals

- Q1. What do the rock paintings found in the rock Shelters of Satpura National Park depict?
- Ans. Figures of animals and men fighting, hunting, dancing, and playing musical instruments are depicted in these paintings.
- Q2. Protected forests are also not completely safe for wild animals. Why?
- Ans. Protected forests are also not completely safe for wild animals because people living in the neighbourhood encroach upon them and destroy them.
- Q3. Some tribals depend on the jungle. How?
- Ans. The forests provide food, fodder and other resources to the tribal people.

  Hence, they depend on forest for their daily requirements.
- Q4. What is the role of biosphere reserves?
- Ans. The biosphere reserves help to maintain the biodiversity and culture of that area. A biosphere reserve may also contain other protected areas in it.
- Q5. What are the protected areas which have been earmarked to protect our flora and fauna and their habitats?
- Ans. To protect our flora and fauna and their habitats, protected areas called sanctuaries, national parks and biosphere reserves have been earmarked.
- Q6. What is ecosystem?
- Ans. An ecosystem is made of all the plants, animals and microorganisms in an area along with non-living components such as climate, soil, river deltas, etc.
