Ans. Rajya Sabha

- i. The Rajya Sabha functions primarily as the representative of the states of India in the Parliament.
- ii. The Rajya Sabha can also initiate legislation and a bill is required to pass through the Rajya Sabha in order to become a law. It, therefore, has an important role of reviewing and altering the laws initiated by the Lok Sabha.
- iii. The members of the Rajya Sabha are elected by the elected members of the Legislative Assemblies of various states.
- iv. There are 233 elected members plus 12 members nominated by the President.
