- Q1. Against whom did France declare a war in 1792?
- Ans. The National Assembly voted in April 1792 to declare war against Prussia and Austria.
- Q2. Why was bastille hated by all in France?
- Ans. Bastille was hated by all, because it stood for the despotic power of the king.
- Q3. When was French declared as republic?
- Ans. On 21 September 1792 it abolished the monarchy and declared France a republic.
- Q4. When did Louis XVI call together an assembly of the Estates General to pass proposals for new taxes?
- Ans. On 5 May 1789, Louis XVI called together an assembly of the Estates General to pass proposals for new taxes.
- Q5. What is 'quillotine' and who invented it?
- Ans. The guillotine is a device consisting of two poles and a blade with which a person is beheaded. It was named after Dr Guillotin who invented it.
- Q6. Who stormed the bastille the fortress prison during the last years of 18th century?
- Ans. A group of several hundred people marched towards the eastern part of the city and stormed the fortress-prison, the Bastille.
